



What will the Centre provide?

- All safety equipment and qualified instruction in all disciplines
- Funding towards selected NGB awards
- Accommodation in shared en-suite room
- Accommodation also has TV lounge, internet access, kitchen and dining area
- All meals will be provided during the placement
- 18 Days holiday entitlement (10 days taken for Christmas holidays) Holiday entitlement can only be taken from March onwards.
- A minimum of 1.5 days off per week and maximum of 2
- £40 pw Personal Allowance from March 15th 2010 to November 14th 2010 (33 weeks)  
(This will be paid weekly into trainee's bank account)
- Access to equipment at cost price through centre ordering

Other Benefits

- Each trainee is assigned a mentor who will provide feedback on your performance. During these feedback sessions you will be encouraged to voice your views and opinions. Each meeting will look to work on a personal development plan which in turn will maximise your progress and development throughout the year.
- Additional taster training laid on throughout the year in other areas such as spinnaker sailing, climbing, hill walking.

How much does the trainee scheme cost?

The course is essentially free; however there will be certain costs that you will have to pay such as:
